

Central Wyoming Groundwater Guardian Teem

Minutes of Meeting
June 28, 2018

Chairman Floyd Field called the meeting to order at 12:10 pm.

Members Present: Floyd Field, Bruce Pedersen, Margaret Teevens and Brian Schroeder with Regional Water.

Brian made a motion to accept minutes of the May 3, 2018 meeting . Bruce seconded. Motion passed.

Floyd discussed the Dempsey Acres water quality reports. One location tested positive two times and another tested positive once. Follow up testing will be performed. Verbal results were given out. Regional to send out written results.

A recent newspaper article was discussed concerning mice in a 10 MGD tank. DEQ is handling. The Casper Creek sewage spill was also discussed including the Russian Olive tree eradication effort.

The Wyoming Water Bank Law was discussed. Wyoming is a head water state and the three major areas of focus are 1. cloud seeding from Casper to Laramie, 2. need for state water storage and 3. California and other states increasing demand for water.

There are a number of current projects that are progressing in Regional Water. The back up generator is a work in progress. They are currently completing the punch list. The alternate backwash tank is still in progress. The wardwell tank will get a new roof this summer with modifications for birds. Airport tank, wyo blvd tank, stream restoration, HDR wellhead protection, scada system and groundwater guardian membership are all moving forward.

Currently the average daily flow is 15-16MGD with peak demand at 26-27 MGD.

The next meeting for July will be called by Brian Schroeder when the HDR wellhead protection plan BMP's are ready for review. Meeting adjourned at 1:10 p.m.
